

Volunteering for Neighbors Network

Neighbors Network helps older adults stay independent, active, and connected in their homes and community. As a Neighbors Network volunteer, you offer your time and talents to help others with tasks that may seem simple, but can mean so much - the difference between someone staying safely in a cherished home or having to leave it.

All volunteering is coordinated through Neighbors Network Volunteer Coordinator to ensure a good match between what a member may need and each volunteer's skills and availability.

Neighbors Network has several ways to volunteer:

- For those involved as regular service volunteers, you will need to complete a Volunteer Application and pass a background check. You will receive e-mails (and occasionally phone calls) with a specific service request; your response is dependent upon your availability. The Volunteer Handbook describes the various services and policies.
- Volunteer drivers have additional requirements: current FL Driver's License, proof of insurance, and a driving record check.
- An initial interview with each volunteer ensures a good match between the volunteer's availability, skills and interests and the needs of Neighbors Network members. Volunteers will participate in an orientation/training prior to volunteering.
- For "occasional" volunteers, Neighbors Network schedules special
 "service days" throughout the year volunteer teams may spend
 several hours helping to organize a garage, tidy a patio, haul away
 debris or donations, etc... Generally these efforts do not require an
 application or background check. Regular volunteers may also be
 involved in these activities. Youth groups, sororities, fraternities, and
 civic clubs are most welcome.
- Office-type opportunities are also available: including preparing mailings, data entry, phone calls, social media input, and table display support at special community events.
