Background-checked volunteers assist with household tasks and social programs, sharing time and talent doing what they enjoy, when they are able, including driving. Services are a phone call away, planned in advance through our volunteer coordinator.

In 2019, more than 800 member services, provided by 45 volunteers, supported members to remain living safely and independently in the community.

Household tasks: organizing, uncluttering, friendly calls and visits, rides to doctors, minor repairs, technology support, and more

Managed by an active volunteer Board and approximately 50 volunteer service providers.

Service area includes Winter Park, Maitland, Eatonville, Casselberry, Fern Park, Baldwin Park, College Park, Audubon Park, parts of Altamonte Springs, and close by neighborhoods.



Monthly Programs: monthly group lunch out, local theater or movie matinee, book club, museum and park walks, classes and more
