Vetted Volunteers assist Members with household tasks, minor repairs, social visits, running errands, technology support, organizing, uncluttering, rides to appointments, haircuts, the grocery store and more. Services are a phone call away, planned in advance through our Volunteer Coordinator.

Monthly Programs: Members meet for park walks, lunch out, book clubs, museum visits and more. Also via Zoom since early 2020.

Service area includes Winter Park, Maitland, Eatonville, Casselberry, Fern Park, Baldwin Park, College Park, Audubon Park, parts of Altamonte Springs, and close by neighborhoods.



Managed by an active all Volunteer Board, Neighbors Network supported Members to remain living safely and independently in their homes by providing over 1,500 volunteered services during 2020-2021.

Membership can cost less than \$1 a day.
